The 2° edition of the Carpathian Fluid Geochemistry Summer School, patronized by the Italian Geochemical Society (So.Ge.I.), the IAVCEI Commission on the Chemistry of Volcanic Gases (CCVG) and Commission on Volcanic Lakes (CVL), will be hosted in the Eastern Carpathians, Romania.

The summer school is addressed to **Bachelor, Master** and **PhD students**. It gathers researchers and professors with diverse expertise in fluid geochemistry, volcanology and hydrogeochemistry.

The main aim is to bring together the next generation of researchers, active in studies concerning **fluid geochemistry**, and to introduce them with innovating measurement and sampling techniques in **different geodynamic settings**.

Field activities will be carried out at (I) Saint Anna crater lake and (II) degassing areas of the Ciomadu volcanic complex.

The students will have the opportunity to experience different techniques of gas and water sampling, measurements of diffuse degassing from soil and lakes, and air contaminants using the multi-gas technique. Activities in the field will be integrated by oral sessions dealing with related topics
